 - Incorporating the Personal Identity Verification (PIV) single sign-on in the existing application log in process to comply with Homeland Security Presidential Directive 12 (HSPD-12), to enhance and standardize secure access to FEMA applications
 - User Impact
 - As PIV cards are activated and assigned to FEMA applications, users will be required to log on using a PIV card instead of manually entering a user ID and password
 - Users external to FEMA (e.g. State and Local responders) will see a dual-authentication page from which they can log in through the existing process
